Application for coasting trade license for M/V Inter Viking, LCLO for the period 22.09.2023 to 21.09.2024

The M/V Inter Viking was operating on the Canadian East Coast under the previous vessel name M/V Viktoria Viking during the period from June 2019 to July 2023. When the previous contract came to an end it was decided to take the vessel back to Norway to have her upgraded for new contracts either in Norway or Scotland. The vessel has now been rewarded a new time charter contract for Mowi Canada East, and this is the reason for why we apply for a new CTL.

The fish farming industry has increased need for wellboat capacity to cover their needs for transport of smolts, harvest and transfers in addition to bath treatments for Sea Lice. A bath treatment of live fish is performed by pumping the fish from the farm cages and into the Wellboat's tanks. In the tanks the fish can either be treated by freshwater or by the introduction of special chemicals. When the treatment time is finished, the fish is transferred back into the cages by a gentle pumping system to avoid any damage of physical stress to the fish.

The Canadian fleet of Wellboats is limited to only 5-6 vessels, and all vessels are under long term time charter contracts with other fish farming companies. InterShip has not been able to find any suitable Canadian Wellboats in the market.

Due to increased activity on the Canadian Atlantic Coast and a change to the internal vessel logistics, Mowi Canada East requires the services of a vessel of M/V Inter Viking's size to ensure that they have good control of the biological aspects of fish farming.

To fulfill Mowi Canada's needs for transport and treatment of Salmon we hereby apply for a new Temporary Coasting Trade License for the M/V Inter Viking.

Typical operations that will be performed by the vessel:

- Transport of live Salmon of sizes varying from 50 grams to 7 kg.
- Size grading of Salmon internally on one Farm location or as part of a fish transfer operation.
- Bath treatments for Sea lice.
- The vessel is capable of long transports on closed system so that there is minimum risk of introducing toxic algae into the vessels tanks.

The vessel will perform transports between all the Mowi Canada East farms on a regular basis. Sometimes daily or multiple trips per day and other times treatments on the same location without transporting the fish from one site to the other. We have been informed that application shall have detailed information about each transport, but the transport plan is normally planned for only one week ahead, so this is not possible.
